NOTES:

- All applications received were accepted and ranked; no projects were rejected.
- Ranked projects were scored, rated and ranked according to the New Bedford CoC's Ranking and Review process outlined in the FY2022 RFP and made available at www.nbhspn.com.
- In accordance with the 2022 CoC NOFO, the ranking follows a two-tier system such that Tier 1 = 95% of the Annual Renewal Demand (ARD) and Tier 2 = the difference between Tier 1 and the max amount of renewal, reallocation and CoC Bonus funds the CoC can apply for (excluding the Planning Grant).
- The amount of funding available for a permanent housing bonus in this 2022 round was \$104,315.
- The amount of funding available for a DV Bonus project in this 2022 round was \$208,630.
- The CoC intends to submit a planning grant in the 2022 round that will, in accordance with the HUD CoC NOFO, remain unranked.
